Roles and Responsibilities:

- Provide pastoral care to church members on a regular basis and as needed, with the
 ability to visit members at church offices and travel to members' homes, facilities, and
 make hospital visits as needed.
- Develop ministry programs for church members across the lifespan, such as education and ministries for children and youth, adult education classes, and membership courses.
- Develop and maintain relationships within the American Baptist Churches (USA), as well as our region American Baptist Churches of the Central Pacific Coast (ABCCPC).
 Regularly attend ministers' meetings, conferences, and be a voice for Grant Park Church locally, regionally, and nationally.
- Manage a small team of part-time, non-pastoral staff.
- Take a leading role in setting the vision for ministry and mission at Grant Park Church.

Skills, Qualifications, and Characteristics:

- A deepening faith in Jesus Christ, embodying characteristics of humility, integrity, love, openness, and regard for the poor and vulnerable.
- A healthy sense of self and demonstrated emotional maturity, conveys empathy and compassion in personal and professional relationships.
- The ability to engage in interpersonal work needed to develop and sustain pastoral relationships with individuals and groups.
- A capacity to tolerate moderate amounts of organizational stress and conflict.
- A commitment to issues of social justice in congregational life and the community.
- Master of Divinity (M.Div.) or equivalent from an accredited theological seminary.
- If not ordained American Baptist Churches (USA), it is expected that the candidate will immediately begin the process of obtaining ordination or recognition by ABCUSA. This requirement is to be completed within the first two years of employment.
